Spring Sports Information:

- Important Policies:
 - Grade checks will be run on Thursdays for the following week's player eligibility teachers are not expected rush grading for work turned in late
 - Transfers from other school are required to sit out 50% of the games need a Transfer Policy signed by the other school before any competitions are played
 - State off day is Sunday no games/practice
 - Baseball club sports cannot be played while we are in season
 - Jersey's need to be returned at the end of the season, otherwise players will be charged
 - No pets/animals at games
 - Resolution Policy: Any concerns on the field need to be addressed by the player with the coach directly. If no resolution, then parent/player and coach will meet. If still no resolution, Athletic Director, Tony will be involved.
